



**Provisional Proposals:**

Taking into account the electorate for each ward and existing constituencies, we draw up Provisional Proposals for Northern Ireland's revised constituencies. We publish the Provisional Proposals Report.

**Publish representations:**

We publish all the responses received, including transcripts of the public hearings, on our website.

**Revised Proposals published:**

If we decide that the evidence presented is such that it is appropriate to change the Provisional Proposals, we publish Revised Proposals.

**Final Recommendations and Report:**

Following the consultation on Revised Proposals, we consider all evidence received throughout the Review, before making final recommendations to the Secretary of State. We must do this by 1st October 2013.

**Initial consultation period:**

We consult on the Provisional Proposals for 12 weeks, making them available to the public. During this time, public hearings take place. We then collate all responses received, including transcripts of the public hearings.

**Secondary consultation period:**

During a 4 week period, the public can make further written submissions about the responses received and published.

**Final consultation period:**

We then consult on Revised Proposals for a further period of 8 weeks. During that consultation period there are no further public hearings, and no opportunity to comment on the responses of others.
